

It may not seem like a big deal but did you know...

Every gallon of used motor oil that is improperly disposed of by throwing it into the trash, pouring it down a storm drain, or out onto the ground pollutes our environment? In the United States the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) estimates that as much as 200 million gallons of used motor oil is disposed of improperly by do-it-yourselfers each year!

Fortunately...

There is an easy solution available to prevent used motor oil pollution – Used Motor Oil and Filter Recycling!

The City of Baldwin Park encourages all its residents to recycle their used motor oil and used motor oil filters. It's quick, it's easy, and it's the right thing to do. Just refer to the map inside this brochure to find the Certified Used Oil Collection location nearest you.

Or, to schedule at-home used motor oil collection, call Waste Management at (626) 960-7551. Place your used motor oil and oil filter at the curb on your regular refuse collection day. Make sure your used motor oil is in a tightly capped container and that your oil filter has been drained and is placed in a tightly sealed plastic bag.

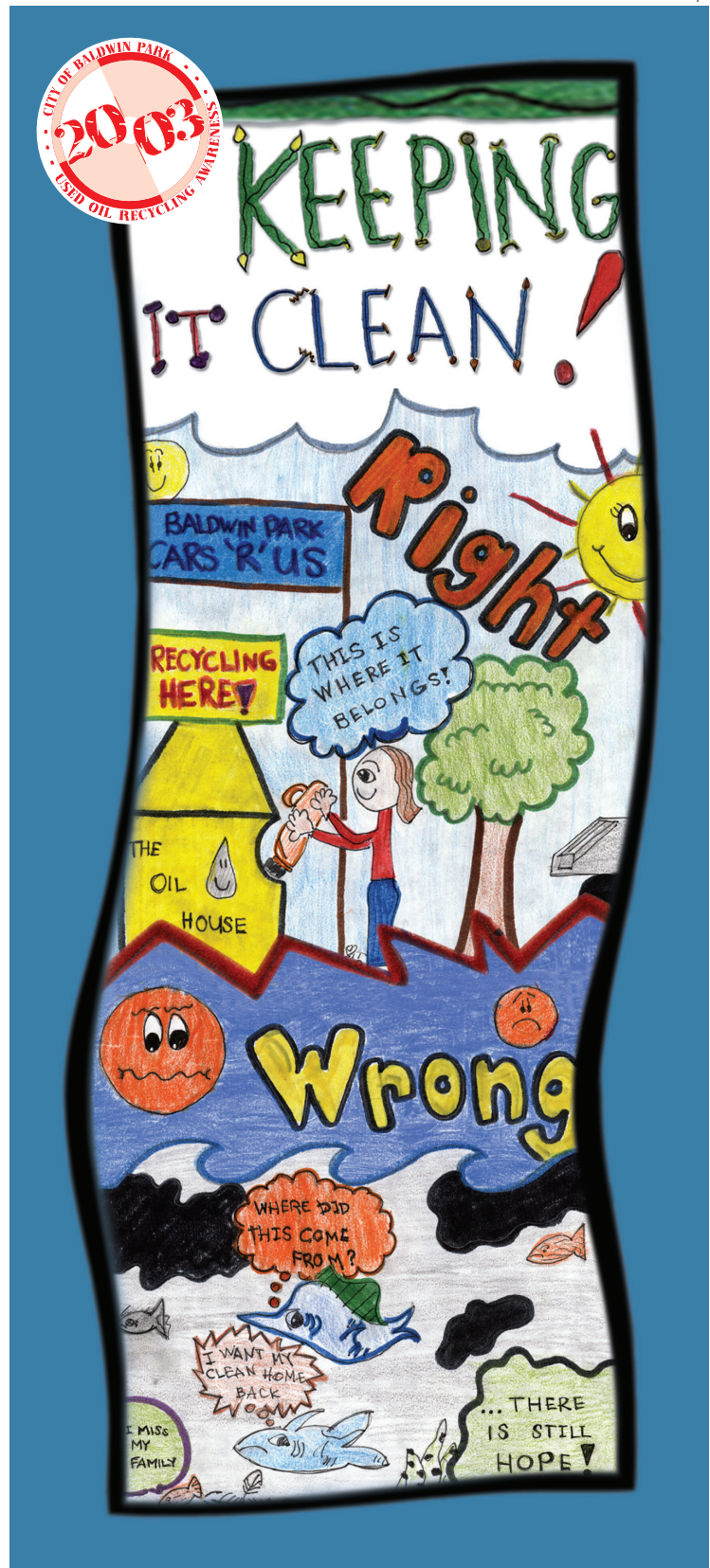

Recycle your used oil and oil filters!

Tips for Recycling Used Motor Oil.

Please call the FREE Collection Center nearest you to verify hours of operation and quantities accepted.

CONTAMINATED OIL – NOT ACCEPTED!

Carry oil in clean, non-breakable containers, no metal containers, please. Place oil filters in a plastic bag to prevent leaks.

Do not mix oil with bleach, paint, solvents, or other automotive fluids.

Maximum container size accepted at collection sites – five gallons. A maximum of three gallons will be accepted curbside as part of Waste Management's at-home collection program.
